This grant will be paid to you by the MSSU Bursar via electronic refund (the quickest option to receive your funds) or a paper check by mail. We anticipate distribution of your funds to occur on or near June 23, 2022. If you elect to have your funds sent via paper check (or do not set up an electronic refund account), checks will mail the following week.

The Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund III (HEERF III) is authorized by the American Rescue Plan (ARP), Public Law 117-2, signed into law on March 11, 2021, providing funds in support to institutions of higher education, like MSSU, to serve students and ensure learning continues during the COVID-19 pandemic.

ARP funds are in addition to funds authorized by the Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2021 (CRRSAA), Public Law 116-260 and the Coronavirus Aid, Recovery, and Economic Security (CARES) Act, Public Law 116-136. Notably, a portion of these funds are intended to be distributed directly to eligible students.

MSSU was approved for \$7,636,833 in financial grants to students under HEERF III, which may be used for any component of the student's cost of attendance or for emergency costs that arise due to coronavirus, such as tuition, food, housing, health care (including mental health care), or child care. Most of those funds were distributed last fall and spring semester, and the remainder will be distributed on or near June 23, 2022.

Students eligible for the \$45 grant under the HEERF III at MSSU are those who:

- 1) Were enrolled at MSSU as of June 16, 2022 for the Summer 2022 semester, and
- 2) Are degree-seeking at MSSU in a certificate, associate, bachelor, or master's academic program.

By accepting the HEERF III grant, you confirm you are eligible to receive these funds as outlined above, and have incurred expenses related to the COVID-19 pandemic.
